

Please see below a statement from the Melbourne Museum with regards to their environmental policies

As a leading institution in cultural, science and education Museum Victoria aims to engage and educate the public in contributing to environmental sustainability. The sustainability strategy which is currently being produced, has the support of the CEO and senior management

As part of this strategy, the Museum Victoria Climate Change Committee has been established to act as a focus, promoter and contact point for climate change and environmental initiatives at Museum Victoria.

Initiatives in relation to energy sources, energy use, water, waste reduction, resource use and staff/public engagement are all in progress. The Museum is also exploring how to minimise the carbon content of its exhibitions, with the assistance of RMIT.

The Melbourne Museum already harvests water via the roof into tanks stored below the building. This plan will be extended to include the Royal Exhibition Building.
